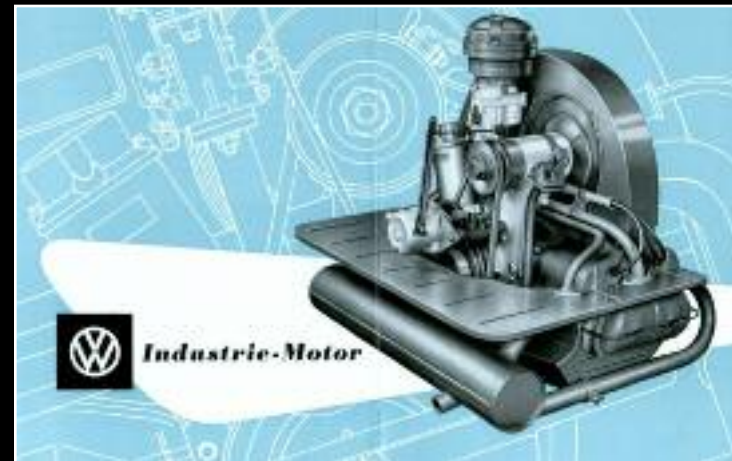

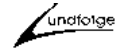

"Setting up the family reunion at the fair is much more relaxed than Thanksgiving or Christmas, when airlines are packed. Plus, it's an event that the entire family enjoys, Sue Davis said."
